GREENPOINT MAISONETTE







THESE NEW YORK APARTMENTS CONJURE UP PARIS, LONDON, AND TOKYO

Colony's Jean Lin helps 40 Bleecker channel the spirit of 1920s Chanel, 1970s punk, and 1980s Comme des Garçons.

Great design can be a kind of time travel. Imagine Coco Chanel's Art Deco digs in 1920s Paris, Vivienne Westwood's London flat at the height of the punk era, or Rei Kawakubo's Tokyo apartment, circa 1985. Each of those spaces captures a particular moment in time like few others.

Design consultant Jean Lin has tried to bring the spirit of those fashionable rooms to a trio of model apartments at 40 Bleecker, a new luxury condominium building in New York City's NoHo neighborhood.

Worrell Yeung and Colony teamed up to design a geometric Union Square abode

Even before they embarked on the renovation of a 3,000-square-foot loft overlooking New York's Union Square, Max Worrell and Jeon Yeung, co-principals of Brooklyn architecture studio Worrell Yeung, and Jean Lin—of the cooperative gallery, design studio, and strategy firm Colony—knew they wanted the interplay of its fundamental geometries to help fuel their design. The loft in question occupies the entire third floor of a triangular, Renaissance Revival-style building designed in 1899 by the German architect Robert Maynicke—a pioneer of these types of modern spaces.

Hilltop hideaway: Colony creates tranquil interiors for a Catskills retreat

Perched between two mountain ranges, this Catskills retreat marries bold, angular architecture with interiors that offer warmth and texture

From its perch on the ridge between the Taconics and Catskills, this upstate New York home makes for a majestic lookout. Designed by Brooklyn architecture firm Worrell Yeung, Ridge House comprises three structures – a main residence, a guest house and a pool house – that lie low in the rugged landscape. Within the boundaries of the 88-acre plot, there is a native hickory oak forest, meadows of fescue that turn green then brown, wild berries, rubbled stone walls, ponds and rocky outcroppings. We've previously explored the Catskills retreat's angular architecture that blends harmoniously with the undulating terrain, but now we're back to take in its interiors, a tactile counterpoint.
